- Award winners will be announced following the last afternoon break.
- Posters should not be removed until the last session has begun.
- IAASC will NOT be responsible for posters left after the conference. IAASC does NOT offer expenses for poster presenters. All expenses paid for by poster author.
- **Display Board** - Each poster presentation MUST be on a 36x48" (Cardboard or Foam) Tri-Fold Display Board.
